Oseminar organized by the institute:

 An All India one day Seminar on "Energy Conservation in Sugar Factories to Boost up Power Exports" was organized on 8th October 2013 jointly by National Sugar Institute, Kanpur & S. Nijlingappa Sugar Institute, Belgaum at Belgaum. The seminar was attended by large nos. of delegates from various states & seven no. research papers on the topics pertaining to Bagasse Gasification, Diffuser & Decanter Technology, Use of Bio Based Food Grade Lubricants etc. for enhancing energy savings were presented.
