## Sub: One-Day Meet at Lucknow on March 15, 2018, Promotion of Distillery/Ethanol Projects along with Incineration Boiler-based Captive Cogen Power Plants in North India

Molasses-based Distillery and Ethanol Plants have excellent potential in North Indian States (Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana and Bihar), considering the target set by Govt. of India and these States for blending of ethanol into petroleum fuel.
