"Improvement of sugar quality with special reference to B-heavy molasses and Cane juice/Syrup diversion for ethanol production by the sugar factories"

The policy of B-heavy, Cane juice/ Syrup diversion for ethanol production has helped the sugar industry to draw a balance between sugar demand-supply and also to generate more revenue. This has helped in clearing the cane bills of cane farmers and improving the economy of the industry, besides offering many other advantages.

The diversion of B heavy, cane juice/ syrup to ethanol production has invited discussions on shortage of melt for boiling of A massecuite, increased vapour load in boiling house, and in fact redrafting fuelsteam-power balance and reconfiguring evaporator station. Additionally industry is required to maintain/improve prevailing sugar quality specially when the sugar factory is diverting the B-heavy /cane juice/syrup for production of ethanol.

In view of the above issues it has been considered timely to deliberate the different issues in the sugar process including improving the quality of sugar. Hence, S Nijalingappa Sugar Institute, Belagavi in collaboration with National Sugar Institute, Kanpur is scheduling a National seminar on the topic.
